AAAA SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE

Scholarships now "dedicated" to spouses of AAAA members
Scholarships also "dedicated" to AAAA Company Grade Officers,
Warrant Officer, Enlisted and Department of the Army Civilian members

■■ BACKGROUND:

The AAAA Scholarship Foundation is a separate non-profit, tax-exempt corporation created to render financial assistance for the college-level education of members of the Army Aviation Association of America, Inc. (AAAA) and spouses, unmarried siblings, unmarried children, and grandchildren of current and deceased AAAA members.

■■ SCHOLARSHIP GRANTS AND LOANS:

Scholarships for entering freshmen range from \$1,000 to \$10,000 grants given out as one, two or four year scholarships; interest-free loans of up to \$4,000 (\$1,000 a year); a scholarship of at least \$4,000 to an applicant pursuing a four-year degree in engineering.

In addition, \$1,000 scholarships will be presented to undergraduate sophomores, juniors or seniors and to graduate students.

Also, \$1,000 scholarships will be "dedicated" to spouses of AAAA members in pursuit of college studies at the undergraduate or graduate level; \$1,000 scholarships will be "dedicated" to AAAA Company Grade Officer members; \$1,000 scholarships will be "dedicated" to AAAA Warrant Officer members; \$1,000 scholarships will be "dedicated" to AAAA Enlisted members; and \$1,000 scholarships will be "dedicated" to Department of the Army Civilian members for full-time or part-time study in pursuit of off-duty educational goals. Dedicated Scholarships are designed to encourage broader participation within these categories. In the event there are fewer applicants than awards for a specific Dedicated Scholarship, the remaining award(s) will be issued to the next most competitive candidate without regard to the category.

■■ AWARD PHILOSOPHY

The AAAA National Scholarships are awarded on the basis of academic merit and personal achievement.

■■ APPLICATION PROCEDURE

To apply, please request a Scholarship Grant/Loan Application from the AAAA Scholarship Foundation, Inc., 755 Main Street, Suite 4D, Monroe, CT 06468-2830, Telephone: (203) 268-2450, FAX: (203) 268-5870, E-MAIL: aaaa@quad-a.org, and return it to the AAAA Scholarship Foundation, Inc., on or before May 1 (postmark will govern). All forms, together with other supporting data, must be received by the Foundation on or before June 1 for consideration by the AAAA Scholarship Selection Committee.

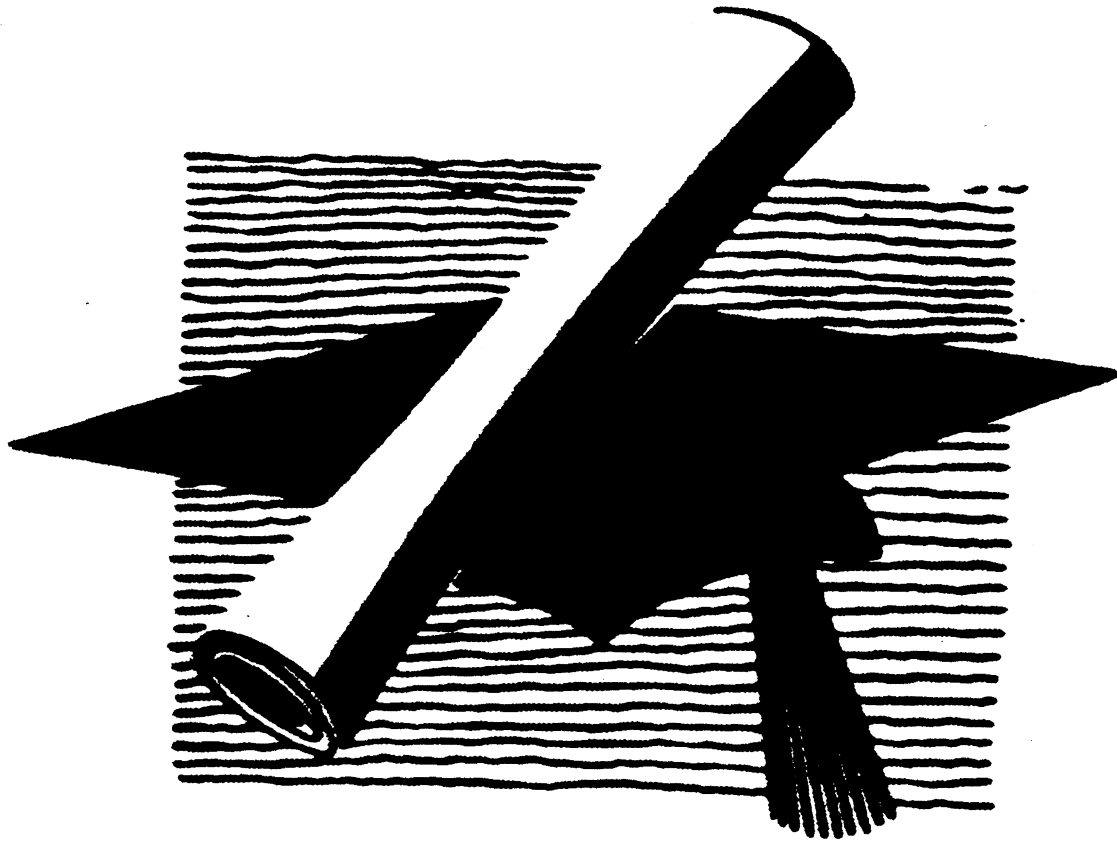
■■ ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

The applicant must be attending an accredited college or university or selected for Fall entry as an undergraduate or graduate student. No recipient can hold concurrent AAAA Scholarships. Applicants who will attend a Service Academy are ineligible for a grant or loan. The AAAA member to which the applicant is related must have an effective date of membership on or before **May 1** of the previous year in which the applicant is seeking aid unless the member is deceased. The one (1) year requirement for all uniformed Active Duty, U.S. Army Reserve and Army National Guard members is automatically waived.

■■ SELECTION AND NOTIFICATION:

Selection of winners will be made by the AAAA National Scholarship Selection Committee during mid-July with each applicant to receive a list of the winners no later than August 15.
